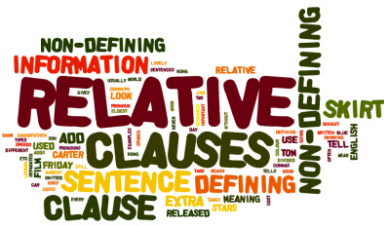

- ▶ When *who*, *which* and *that* are used to introduce a relative clause, they are called **relative pronouns**.
- ▶ *Who* refers to people and *which* to things; *that* can refer to both people and things.
- ▶ *Who*, *which* and *that* can be **the subjects** in relative clauses as in *Sentence 1*.
- ▶ *Who*, *which* and *that* can also be **the objects** in relative clauses as in *Sentence 2 & 3*. In this case, the relative pronouns can be left out.
